E. Eakin on South by lands of Perry Arnold and Ed. Prosser on West by lands of William Hodges, so that she, the said party of the first part, her heirs, executors and administrators or assigns, nor any other person or persons for her, them, or any of them, shall not have claim, challenge, or demand, or pretend to have claim, challenge, or demand, any dower, or any other right, title claim or demand whatsoever of in, and to the same, or any part or parcel thereof, in whatsoever lands, tenements, or possession, the same may or can be and thereof and therefrom shall be utterly barred and excluded forever by these presents.
