paid by William No Stokes of the County and State aforesaid,  
said, have bargained and sold, and by these presents do  
grant bargain sell convey and give unto the said  
William No Stokes all that piece and parcel of land  
situate lying & being in the County of Greenville & the State  
aforesaid, on branches of Beaverdam Creek, waters  
of Saluda River, Beginning on a stone on South  
line thence running N 81 W 16.35 to stone corner thence  
N 76 W 21.18 stone corner thence S 17 1/2 W 9.85 to stone corner  
thence S 7 1/2 W 3.50 to stone corner thence N 85 E 39.30 to  
stone corner thence S 46 E 42.70 to stone corner thence N 82  
E 10.75 stone corner thence N 72 1/2 W 14.28 piece stump corner  
thence N 38 1/2 W 35.90 to Hickory corner thence N 81 W 10.50  
to stone corner thence S 15 1/4 W 13.50 to the beginning corner  
containing one hundred and twelve acres more or  
less bounded by lands of Frank Austin, Mrs Fannie E  
Stokes, Fielding Smith and others, together with all

William P Bomar of the County of Greenville in the State  
aforesaid have granted bargain sold and released and  
by these presents do grant bargain sell and release unto  
the said William P Bomar his heirs and assigns all  
that certain tract portion or parcel of land situated  
lying and being in the aforesaid State and County  
on both sides of the Saluda Gap road and on both  
sides of Thompson's Beaverdam Creek and known  
as lot No 2 in the division of the real Estate of Wil-  
liam Bomar dec beginning at a stone on the South  
side of said Saluda Gap Road and running N 58  
E 43.50 to a stone corner thence S 24 E 31.10 to a stone
