Bull all that piece parcel and tract of land situated lying & being the County & State aforesaid on the West side of the Air Line R.R. & having the following buttings & boundaries (viz) Beginning at Saluda River near the mouth of the Spring Branch, on a bush & thence N. E. 200 ft. to the intersecting cross line thence S. E. to the Rail Road to a stake thence South with the R.R. to the bridge at the River thence up the River to the beginning corner bounded by the lands of R. A. Meaus & Wm. Whitman containing Twenty & 1/4 (20 1/4) Acres more or less.

Together with all and singular the rights members hereditaments and appurtenances to the said premises belonging or in anywise incident or appertaining. To have and to hold all and singular the said premises before mentioned unto the said Sarah A. Bull her heirs and assigns forever, and I do hereby bind myself & my heirs executors and administrators to warrant and forever defend all and singular the said premises unto the said Sarah A.
