Freeman of Greenville County in the State aforesaid, (the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged) have granted bargained sold and released, and by these presents do grant bargain, sell and release unto the said M. D. Freeman all that certain lot or parcel of land situate being in the same

and State aforesaid on the N.W. side of the road leading from P. E. Suncaw's old place to Reedy River Church, beginning at a forked Chestnut 3x dead and down, and running with said road 26.00 chains to a stone, thence N 60 W 8.60 to a stone 3x thence S 28 1/2 W 16.00 to a stone 3x Spanish Oak gone, thence S 11 1/2 E 20.00 to stone 3x Red Oak gone, thence S 6 1/2 E 9.26 to the beginning Chestnut corner, containing eighteen acres more or less marked on the plat lot No. 3, being the interest of M. D. Freeman in the tract of land formerly owned by W. D. Moon deed, together with all and singular the rights, members, hereditaments and appurtenances to the said premises belonging or in anywise incident or appertaining, To have and to hold, all and singular the said premises before mentioned unto the said M.
