Wasson on or about the 25th day of November in the year of our Lord eighteen hundred and eighty exhibited his complaint in the Court of Common Pleas for the County aforesaid, against Samuel Wasson Robert Wasson and others demanding judgment in relation to the real estate hereinafter mentioned and described; and the cause being at issue came on to be heard on the 11th day of July 1882 and such proceedings were had therein as resulted in a decretal order of the said Court, whereby it was adjudged and decreed that the said real estate hereinafter mentioned and described, be sold by S. J. Douthick Master in and for the County aforesaid on the terms and for the purposes mentioned in the said decretal order as by reference thereto on file in said Court will appear; and the said Master after having duly advertised the said real estate for sale by public outcry, on the second day of October in the year of our Lord eighteen hundred and eighty two did then openly and publicly and according to the custom of auction, sell and dispose of the same unto David R. Douthick Master in and for the County of Greenville aforesaid in consideration of the sum of Six hundred and three Dollars to me paid by the said David R. Anderson the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged have granted bargained sold and released and by these presents do grant sell and release unto

release, unto the said David R. Anderson, all that tract of land situate lying and being in the County of Greenville and State aforesaid, Beginning at a stone 3x on a branch, thence S 7 1/2 E 20.00 to a maple 3x. thence S 8 1/4 W 21.50 to a stake 3x. thence S 5 1/4 W 17.18 to a Pine, thence N 36 1/4 W 21.10 to a white Oak 3x on a branch, thence down said branch to a stake on the branch first mentioned, thence up said branch 37.50 chains to the beginning corner adjoining lands of Dr D R Anderson and others, and containing one hundred and two acres, more or less Together with all and singular the rights members hereditaments and appurtenances to the said premises belonging, or in any wise incident or appertaining; and all the estate, right, title claim and interest whatsoever, of the parties to the cause aforesaid, and of each of them, in and to the same and of all other persons rightfully claiming from, under, or by these or any of them, To have and to hold, all and singular the premises before mentioned, unto the said David R.
