Keunt and Kattie Keunt have granted bargained sold and released and by these presents do grant bargain sell and release unto the said J.P. Keunt and Kattie Keunt all that tract of land situate lying and being in the County and State aforesaid adjoining lands of David Adams, Perry Robertson and others, and containing one hundred and seven acres more or less together with all and singular the rights, members, hereditaments and appurtenances to the said premises belonging, or in any wise incident or appertaining To have and to hold all and singular the premises before mentioned unto the said J.P. Keunt and Kattie Keunt their heirs and assigns forever, and I do hereby bind myself my heirs executors and administrators to warrant and forever defend all and singular the said premises unto the said J.P. Keunt and Kattie Keunt their heirs and assigns against me and my heirs and every other person or persons lawfully claiming or to claim the same, or any part thereof Reserving unto myself and to my husband & Hightower, all the rights and privileges claimed and mentioned in said agreement herein referred to as a part of this instrument

Green of Greenville County in the State aforesaid, have granted bargained sold and released, and by these presents do grant bargain sell and release unto the said George B. Green a certain piece parcel or tract of land lying and being situate in Greenville County in the State aforesaid on both sides of Char Creek waters of South Tyger River and containing one hundred and seventeen acres more or less and hath such marks bounds &c as follows viz Beginning at a sweet gum on the bank of South Tyger river and running thence S 16 1/2 E 11.68 to a stone 3x thence S 77 E 24.65 to a stone 3x n.w. thence S 32 1/2 E 30.25 to a stone 3x n.w. thence S 73 W 17.00 to a stone on the creek near Washington Taylor's Mill thence N 32 W 16.50 to a stone 3x s.w. thence S 85 W 1.10 to sweet gum 3x s.w. thence N 23 W 2.00 to a stone 3x n.w. thence W 85 W 10.00 to a P.O. 3x thence S 89 W 11.00 to a Hickory at the Grave yard thence N 77 W 6.30 to a stone at the Pond thence S 79 W 4.42 to a stone 3x n.w. thence North 11.45 to stake in the branch near the head thence down said branch with its meanders to the river thence down the river to the beginning bounded by lands of Washington Taylor W.
