Shumate and P. H. Reilly, by and under the name, firm and style of Gowers, Shumate and Reilly and whereas the said Helen J. Shumate, desires to withdraw from the said firm and business, and to sell and dispose of all her interest therein to the said Sallie M. Gowers and P. H. Reilly; and whereas the said Sallie M. Gowers and P. H. Reilly, have con- sented to the said withdrawal of the said Helen J. Shumate, and have agreed to purchase her inter- est in said firm and business, and for the sum of Thirty three hundred Dollars, and to continue the said business together as partners by and under the name, firm and style of Gowers and Reilly, and whereas in accordance with the said agreement the said Sallie M.
