dollars to me paid in hand by Andrew Kinsey
Willis of Greenville County in the State aforesaid
have granted bargained sold and released, and by
these presents do grant bargain sell and release unto
the said Andrew K. Willis all that tract of land
lying in Greenville County lying on the head waters
of Bush Creek of South Tyger River, containing
one hundred acres more or less bounded by lands
of Joseph P. Pitman on the South and the East by
Robert Pitman East on the North by Benj. Amie
Healy and A. K. Willis on the West by Daniel
Southern. It being a tract of lands granted to Simon
Middleton in AD 1844 and conveyed to me by the
said Simon Middleton September the 26th in the
year of our Lord one thousand eight hundred and
fifty five. Together with all and singular the rights
members hereditaments and appurtenances to the said
premises belonging, or in anywise incident or appertain-
ing. To have and to hold all and singular the said
premises before mentioned unto the said Andrew
Kinsey Willis, his heirs and assigns forever,
and I do hereby bind myself and my heirs executors
and administrators to warrant and forever
defend all and singular the said premises unto
the said Andrew Kinsey Willis his heirs and
assigns against me and my heirs, and all
other person or persons lawfully claiming, or to
claim the same or any part thereof.
