Westmoreland and George Westmoreland will support my wife and myself during our natural lives. Have granted bargained sold and released and by these presents do grant bargain sell and release unto the said Thomas P. Westmoreland and George Westmoreland all of those two certain pieces parcels and lots of land situate lying and being in Greenville County in the State aforesaid and about fifteen miles North of the Court House and described as follows. The first tract lies on both sides of Beaver Dam Creek and known as the mill place contains one hundred acres and is bounded by lands of J. Wellis W. L. Westmoreland, J. P. Westmoreland and George Westmoreland. The second tract contains thirty three acres and lies at the head of Beaver Dam Creek and is bounded by lands of Archie Mitchell, W. P. F. Neves and others also all the mineral interests which I have heretofore reserved in the land which I have conveyed to my several children at various times heretofore and also all the mineral interests which I shall reserve in the tract of land which I propose hereafter to convey to my several children W.
