Harrison of Greenville County in the State aforesaid, have granted, bargained, sold and released, and by this present do grant, bargain, sell and release unto the said John H. Harrison all our rights title and interest in that piece of land and tract of land, containing Two hundred and eighty six acres, more or less, said interest being two undivided thirds, situate, lying and being in Fairview Township in the County and State aforesaid on Cripple Creek of Reedy River adjoining lands of H. M. City, S. E.
