ents, That the John H. Harrison
and Richard Harrison of
Summerville County, in the State aforesaid, in consid-
eration of the sum of Four thousand dollars to us
paid by Edward Harrison, of Summerville County in
the State aforesaid, have granted, bargained, sold,
and released, and by these presents do grant, con-
firm, sell and release unto the said Edward
Harrison, all our rights, title and interest that
we, parents and tract of land containing three
hundred acres more or less, said interest being two
undivided thirds, situated, lying, and being in
the said Summerville County and State aforesaid
on Kiddy River and the further Bridge Road, and
known as Tract No. one or Nassau Tract of the lands
of the Estate of John H. Harrison deceased, Beginning
at a sweet gum 3x at the north end of further Bridge
and running thence N 3/4 E 3,00 to a point in the old
road, thence with said road about N 30 E, 1000 to a
point in the road, thence with said road 46,00 to a
stain 3x, thence N 48 3/4 W 54,00, to a Red oak 3x on a
road, thence S 30 W 35,00 to a Sycamore 3x on the
river, thence down the various meanderings of the river
including the Islands of the same, to the beginning;
Together with all and singular the Rights, liberties,
Hereditaments and appurtenances to the said Prem-
ises belonging, or in any wise incident or apper-
taining to the said Premises belonging to the Estate of John
H. Harrison and to hold all and singular the
Premises before mentioned unto the said Edward
Harrison his heirs and assigns forever, And we
do hereby bind ourselves, our heirs, Executors and
Administrators, to warrant and forever defend
all and singular the said Premises unto the
said Edward Harrison his heirs and assigns
against us and our heirs, and all other per-
sons, whomsoever lawfully claiming or to claim
the same or any part thereof. Witness our hands
