of the sum of One Thousand dollars to be  
paid by Edward Harrison, of Greenville County in  
the state aforesaid, have granted, bargained, sold  
and released, and by these presents, do grant, con-  
vey, sell and release unto the said Edward  
Harrison, all their rights, title and interest that  
they, separate and tract of land, containing there  
hundred acres more or less, paid interest being two  
hundred dollars, situate, lying, and being in  
their said Township in the County and State aforesaid  
on Ready River and the Jenkins Bridge Road, and  
known as Tract to own on Jenkins Track, of the lands  
of the Estate of John H. Harrison deceased, Beginning  
at a Survey Tree 3X at the mouth end of Jenkins Bridge  
and running thence N 37 E 3,00 to a point in the old  
road, Thence with said road about N 30 E 1,000 to a  
point in the road, Thence with said road 46.00 to a  
Stone 3X, Then S 48 1/4 W 54,00 to a Red oak 3X own a  
road, Thence S 52 W 35,00 to a Sycamore 3X own the  
river, Thence down the various meanderings of the river  
including the Islands of the same, to the beginning  
together with all and singular the Rights, members,  
Hereditaments and appurtenances to the said Premises  
belonging, or in any wise in right or interest  
After a great pause had for purpose belonging to the estate of John H. Harrison his heirs and executors and administrators to hold all and singular the  
Premises before mentioned into the said Edward  
Harrison his heirs and assigns forever. And we  
do hereby bind ourselves, executors and

against us and our heirs, and all other per-
