Kiblett and myself, Now if I the said Ann Viola Kiblett, and my said husband James M. Kiblett or either of us shall survive the said Susan E. Turripson and the said lot of land - of land shall not be disposed of us before her death; or if the said Susan E. Turripson shall survive both my husband and myself, or I shall dispose of said lot of land during her life time, and the said One thousand dollars and interest shall be well and truly paid, then the above obligation is to be null, void and of no effect; otherwise to remain of full force and virtue,

 whereof is hereby acknowledged, I have granted,
 bargained, sold and released, and by these
 presents do grant, bargain, sell and release
 unto the said James Adams a lot of land in
 the City of Greenville containing One eighth
 (1/8) of an acre more or less and containing and
 bounded as follows: On the North by a street
 running from Main St to the C. & G. Rail Road
 track on the South, by land of Daniel Arnold
 on the East by land now owned by Edward
 Kelsey and on the West by a street running
 to Dan Arnold, together with all and singu-
 lar the Rights, numbers, Street names and
 appurtenances to the said Premises belonging
 or in anywise incident or appertaining.

To have and to hold, all and singular the
 said Premises before mentioned unto the
 said James Adams his heirs and assigns for-
 ever. And I do hereby bind myself my
 heirs, Executors and administrators, to
 warrant and forever defend all and singu-
 lar the said Premises unto the said
 James Adams his heirs and assigns, against
 me and my heirs and assigns, lawful
 by claiming or to claim the same, or any part
 thereof.
