444 Phos J. Earle To Goumsville Seminary Agreement State of South Carolina Goumsville County

Know all men by these presents that Phos J. Earle of the State of South Carolina, for and in consideration of the sum of ten hundred dollars of legal tender United States money to him in hand paid by the Goumsville Seminary, have granted, sold, released, conveyed

unto do grant, bargain sell & release unto the Goumsville Seminary the right to have & to have the Trustees of the Goumsville Seminary in to have to each & to their successors as such also to the Worshipful Master, Wardens & members of Goumsville Lodge No 107 A. P. M. & to their successors as such a certain tract parcel or lot of land situated lying & being in the town of Goumsville on the North side of the road leading to Camp Hill at the Sparta bury bounded by land belonging to my self lying between the stone house lot & the lot lately occupied by Thomas Stewart & on which the main line, graded & conveyed to the neighborhood to the above named Lodge of A. P. M. to be used for school or educational purposes by the former, & for a meeting place & Lodge room by the latter, bounded as follows - Vize: Begin on a Red Oak on the North side of the Sparta bury road & run S 81 E along said road 3.9 a chains to a stake in the road, thence N 5 1/2 W 1/2 E chains to a Post oak, thence S 81 W 3.9 a chains to a stone thence S 5 1/2 E 5 chains to the beginning corner, containing one acre & nearly three fourths of an acre.

Together with all & singular the rights, manors, tenements & appurtenances therunto belonging or in anywise incident or appertaining, to have and to hold all & singular the premises before mentioned unto the persons or parties named above to them & to their successors forever, And I do hereby bind my self, my heirs, Executors, & administrators, to warrant & forever defend all & singular the said premises unto the said parties & to their successors against me, my heirs & against any other person or persons lawfully claiming the same or any part thereof.
