 it was said Association divided said lot into two
 parts, and deeded one part thereof to David C. Williams
 and the other to R. E. Henderson, who deeded the
 same to Benjamin T. Miller and they to Emma G. Goodlett
 and as said said Trust Estate has been taken
 out of the hands of said Thomas G. Jones and Whitman
 S. Symmes as Trustees as aforesaid, and is being
 administered by said court, and said Association
 is now defunct by reason of having been
 dissolved, and as said Emma G. Goodlett on or about
 the 7th day of July 1883, exhibited by Petition in said court
 in the name of Whitman S. Symmes against Whitman S. Symmes and
