dollars to me paid by Robert Scott of the County of Greenville in the State of South Carolina, have granted, conveyed, sold and released, and by these presents do grant, convey, sell and release unto the said Robert Scott all of that certain piece, parcel and tract of land, situate lying and being in the County of Greenville in the State of South Carolina, containing One Hundred and Seventeen Acre more or less, and has the following Metes and Bounds, Beginning on a white Oak 3x and running thence S 50° 16' 50" to a stake 3x thence S 70° 49' E 33.80 to a Post Oak 3x thence S 1° 31' 40" to a stake 3x on the Branch, thence S 8° 00' 00" said branch to a stake 3x at the mouth, thence up Little Horse Creek to a Maple 3x, thence up the Spring Branch to the beginning, Being the same tract of land deeded to the late Elizabeth Roberts by Robert Scott in 1859 and the title to which was vested in me by Act of the General Assembly of South Carolina, approved December in the 21st 1882, said land is bounded by land of Robert Scott, et al Steps and others.
