 Carolina in consideration of the sum of Three Dollars
 to me in hand paid by Victoria E. Jennings
 as well as in consideration of the love and af
 fection which I have for my said daughter
 have granted, bargained, sold, and released,
 and by these presents do grant, bargain
 sell and release unto the said, Victoria
 E. Jennings, a certain piece parcel and
 tract of land situate lying and being in
 the County of Greenville in the State afore
 said, on the West side of the Middle Fork
 of Saluda River, it being a portion of a
 tract of land known as the McPunkin
 tract and conveyed to me by a deed from
 David Bly the Executor of the last will
 and testament of Samuel M. Fountain de
 ceased, executed on the 28th day of March
 A. D. 1866 and recorded in Office of Reg
 istrar of Meigs County as for Greenville
 County Book B. P. 76. The said McPun
 kin tract above mentioned, is divided
 nearly in equal parts by the Middle Fork
 of Saluda River, and it is the portion
 thereof lying west of said River that is
 sold to be conveyed to the said Victoria E.

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
