 State aforesaid, Beginning at a Black Gum  
 Sapling 34 3/4 or in Proter Creek, running thence S  
 44 W 22 00 chains to a Pine Tree 38 or thence  
 S 28 E 54 25 chains to a Dogwood 38 or in Pine  
 Creek, thence down said Creek to the begin-  
 ning of a piece of land of Anderson Jones  
 W. P. Vaughan and others containing One

hundred and twenty three acres, more or less, Being
