and County of Greenville, in the State aforesaid, in consideration of the sum of Two hundred and forty five Dollars to me in hand paid at and before the sealing of these presents by Thomas Sloan of the City and County of Greenville (the receipt whereof is here by acknowledged) have granted, bargained, sold and released, and by these presents do grant, bargain, sell and release unto the said Thomas Sloan, all that piece, parcel and lot of land lying and being in the City and County of Greenville and State of South Carolina containing seven tenths of an Acre more or less, and having the following lines, to wit: to wit: bounded to the North by the South East corner of lot previously purchased of me by Thomas Sloan and running thence with Charles Lane South 86° 00' E two chains and ninety links to the West side of main street thence with main street North 18° 30' East two chains and twenty three links to the North East corner of lot previously sold by me to Thomas Sloan, thence South 81° 30' West two chains and twenty four links with Thomas Sloan line to the beginning as surveyed by Joseph Brannon.

Together with all and singular the Rights, members, Hereditaments, and appurtenances to the said premises belonging, or in anywise incident thereto appertaining. To have and to hold all and singular the said premises before mentioned unto the said Thomas Sloan his heirs and assigns forever. And I do hereby bind myself, my heirs, executors and administrators, to warrant and forever defend all and singular the said premises unto the said Thomas Sloan his heirs and assigns, against me and my heirs and against every person who or lawfully claiming, or to claim the same or any part thereof. Witness my hand and seal, this 31<sup>st</sup> day of December in the year of our Lord One thousand eight hundred and eighty three, and in the One hundred and fourty of the Sovereignty and Independence of the United States of America.
