To S. Lease This Agreement made and  
Witnessed by Patters entered into this the Four-  
teenth Day of April in the year of Our Lord One  
thousand Eight hundred and Eighty-four Be-  
tween Mrs Jane Combley of the first part and  
W.W. Gilmire and Avery Patter of the firm of  
Avery Patter of the second part all of the  
City and County of Greenville and State  
aforesaid. Witnesseth that the party of the  
first part has rented and leased, and doth  
hereby rent and lease unto the parties of  
the second part for the full term of Fifteen  
from the first day of September 1884. The  
Basement first and Second Stories of a certain  
two story Brick Stone house situated by  
me and being on the east side of Main street  
directly opposite the Mansions known in the  
City of Greenville. The party of the first part  
agrees to build an extension of fifty feet  
long two stories and basement and same will  
be front portion of the house, making the build-  
ing One hundred and fifty feet long, looking  
out the back wall making the first floor  
in One room and tear away the stairs at the  
end in rear of present building, and put  
them in the rear end of the first floor.

to build what ever partitions, shelving &c in the  
second story as the parties of the second part  
desire necessary to carry on their business. The  
party of the first part further agrees to put up  
a Back Elevator with safety catch, running from  
basement to the top story, all necessary & suitable  
shelving & how windows, Silver wire cases, Croc-  
ery stands, stands for stores, Counter top cases  
etc, an office &c, and that the arrangement  
of the above mentioned shelving &c shall be de-  
picted by the parties of the second part. The par-  
ty of the first part agrees to complete the build-  
ing at least two weeks before the lease com-  
mences and allow the parties of the second part  
to move in at that time and to make no charge  
for rents until the lease commences. The party  
of the first part further agrees that in case  
the adjoining building or buildings are ex-  
tended, then the said party of the first part shall  
at once put in an other story, etc. The parties  
of the second part covenants and agrees to  
pay with the parties of the first part to pay  
her for said building an annual rental of  
Eight Thousand Dollars, payable monthly  
and it is mutually agreed between the said  
parties that in case the said building is  
destroyed by fire or otherwise etc and  
shall cease. The party of the first part  
agrees to pay for all necessary repairs.
