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This Agreement made and
entered into this 9th day of May A.D. 1884, by
and between Francis Hall of the one part, and
J. M. Pool of the other part, all of the City of
Orangeville, County and State aforesaid, wit-
nesseth, The said Francis Hall hereby rents ^{as}
Lease to the said J. M. Pool the stone bounded
rooms over the same, situated by my and being
on Main Street in the City, County and State
aforesaid, its being the same premises now
occupied by the said J. M. Pool for the full
term of Ten (10) years, commencing at the date
of these presents, upon the following terms and
Conditions, to wit: The said J. M. Pool hereby
agrees and binds himself to pay to the said
Francis Hall as rent for said premises the
full and just sum of Four Hundred Dollars
per annum, to be paid in monthly instal-
ments of Thirtysix and $\frac{3}{4}$ Dallars per month.
The said Hall further agrees on his part to keep
up all necessary repairs on said premises
above mentioned. And it is hereby expressly
agreed by and between the said parties that
in case the said building should be destroyed
or by fire, then and in such case the lessor
or agreement to be utterly null and void and
and to cease and determine. That in case
there is nothing worth repairing
