Debtless Manufacturing Company  
 Against Thomas W. Davis Supplement

by Proceedings having been instituted upon  
 judgment in this action, against Thomas W.  
 Davis the judgment debtor by an order here  
 to fore made by me, and the said Thomas  
 W. Davis having been examined on oath con  
 cerning his property, now upon hearing the  
 testimony taken by the Master, and argu  
 ment of Counsel, It is ordered that David P.  
 Verrier Esq. hereby is appointed receiver of the  
 debts, property, equitable interests rights, and  
 Chasis in Action of the said Thomas W. Davis  
 that said receiver before entering upon the dis  
 charge of his trust, do file with the clerk of the  
 Court, his bond with sufficient security to be  
 approved by the Master in the sum of ten

thousand dollars, conditioned for his faithful  
 discharge of the duties of said trust, that upon  
 the filing of said bond the said D. P. Verrier  
 be vested with all the rights, and powers of re  
 ceiver, according to law, with leave to said Re  
 ceiver forthwith, to institute such proceedings  
 as he may be advised for the recovery of the  
 property of the said Davis wheresoever and who  
 ever hands the same may be, and to hold all  
 funds and property coming into his hands as  
 Receiver subject to the further order of this Court  
 except as hereinafter provided. It is further or  
 dered that the said Thomas W. Davis, and all  
 other persons having in their possession or un  
 der their control, property of the said Davis not  
 exempt from execution, be and they are hereby  
 required to deliver the same to said receiver on  
 demand. It is further ordered that the plaintiffs  
 be allowed the usual costs of this proceedings  
 to be taxed by the Clerk, together with thirty  
 dollars in addition, for his disbursements  
 said costs and disbursements to be paid to  
 the plaintiffs Attorney by the receiver out of  
 any funds first coming into his hands. It is  
 further ordered that Charles A. David Lee and  
 he is hereby required forthwith to assign  
 to the said Receiver the judgment against  
 W. A. Henderson and Rosaline Henderson, assigned  
 to the said Charles A. David Lee by Thomas W.  
 Davis on the 20<sup>th</sup> day of January 1882, that  
 said receiver do proceed to collect and hold  
 the proceeds thereof subject to the further
