up said branch to an Oak 34 m, thence S 15 W 1.77 to a stone 34 m, thence S 69 W 9, 18 to a Stone 34 m near a four moud, thence S 39 1/4 W 23, 25 to a P. O. 34 m thence S 47 W 27, 70 to a Spanish Oak 34 m thence S 55 1/2 W 11, 60 to a stone on said road, thence S 47 E 34, 75 to the beginning, adjoining lands of said A. J. Creighton, James B. Jones and others, and containing Three hundred acres more or less.
