Jones and Elizabeth Jones of said County and State for and in consideration of Fifty Dollars to us hereinafter coming amount awarded to us by arbitrators appointed for the purpose of assessing the value of the Right of Way therein employed, have granted, bargained sold and released, and by these presents do grant bargain sell and release unto the Greenville and Laurens Rail Road Company, the right of Way fifty feet in width through our land, to be measured from the center of track 25 feet in each direction, situated in said County and State within the corporate limits of the City of Greenville, about one and one quarter mile a North East direction from the Court House, adjoining lands of Dr. Norwood, Williard Dawkins, said right of Way contains about Seventy Eight one fourth of an acre more or less. We have and to hold said Right of Way to the said the Greenville and Laurens Rail Road Company and their successors and assigns, for rail Road purposes forever. And We hereby warrant and defend the said Right of Way to the said Rail Road Company and its successors and assigns for rail Road purposes against us and our heirs and all persons lawfully claiming or to claim the same or any part thereof.
