these presents do grant, bargain, sell and release
unto the said J. M. Langley, all that piece, parcel
or tract of land situate, lying and being in the
County of Greenville and state aforesaid adjoining
lands of Perry Noble, Samuel Langley, James L. of his
and the said James M. Langley, and containing
Two and one half acres, more or less, being the
same piece of land which the Court of Probate
of said County, by a decree dated 29th of January
1876, authorized the said James M. Langley as Guardi-
an of the said W. C. Dill to pay out One hundred dol-
lars of his Wards estate, together with all and sing-
ular the rights, members, hereditaments and ap-
