 Deed Know all men by these presents, that I, Alexander M. Bee of the County of Greenville, in the state aforesaid for and in consideration of the sum of One Hundred and ten Dollars, to me paid by R. H. Earle of said County of Greenville, in the state aforesaid have granted, bargained sold and released, and by these presents do grant, bargain, sell and release unto the said R. H. Earle a certain flat or parcel of Land in the County & State aforesaid about two miles from the City of Greenville on Brushy Creek Beginning on the West side of 2^d Creek at a Maple stump on the Bank of Creek and runs thence Crossing the Goose Road S 16 1/2° E One ch. & 2 links to a P. O. Stump thence S 67° W One ch & 0.7 links to a Red O. Stump thence S 44° W 3 ch & 12 Lks to a Maple Stump near the bk of the Langley Spring branch thence S 8 1/2° E crossing 2^d branch 3 ch. & 20 links to a stake near side of M. 13^o Mill R^e thence S 132° E One Chain, 50 links to a stake near the same R^e thence S 20° E One ch, 17 links to stake by Pine stump thence S 126° two ch & 6.5 Lks to a stake near R^e above mentioned thence S 41° One ch, 86 Lks to a stake on lower side of 2^d R^e thence S 53° E one ch, 9 links to Pine Stump on lower side of same R^e thence S 66° 30' ch. 5 links to a stake on lower side of R^e thence S 40° E thirty five links to a stake not far from the head of back water of M. 13^o Pond thence crossing head of said Pond S 32° E four ch. 75 links to an old dead tree not far from the edge of Pond thence up the Pond S 6 1/2° E four ch. 23 links to a stake thence up the meandering of 2^d Brushy Creek to the beginning on the bk of the Creek (south side, & west side of Goose R^e is also a corner of P. S. Mills land) containing by survey of W. P. Johnson D. S. Four acres & three fourths, and is all to the left of M. 13^o Mill R^e going down & between 2^d R^e & the Creek. Earle his heirs and assigns forever, And against mine and my heirs, and other persons lawfully claiming or to claim the same in any part thereof.
