 no 3 Order appointing Receiver County of Greenville  
 to Cunningham Court of Common Pleas

An order having been heretofore duly made by me, pursuant to the provisions of the Code of Procedure, requiring the above named Cunningham Pennington to make discovery on oath before S. Douthett Esq. Master, to whom it was referred by me to examine the said Cunningham Pennington in proceedings supplementary to execution in relation to his property and it appearing from the testimony taken by the said Master thereunder that the said Cunningham Pennington has property which he unjustly refuses to apply to the satisfaction of his indebtedness, Now, on motion of W. L. Wait, attorney for the plaintiffs in this action, It is ordered, That David P. Ferver, Esq. be and he hereby is appointed Receiver of all the debts, property, equitable interests, rights, and things in action of the said Cunningham Pennington

that such receiver, before he enter upon the execution of his trust, execute and file with the clerk of this Court a bond, with sufficient sureties, to be approved by the Master of this County, in the sum of Two hundred Dollars, conditioned that he will faithfully discharge the duties of such trust; and that the said receiver, upon filing such bond, be invested with all the rights and powers as receiver according to law; and the said Cunningham Pennington, and all other persons having in their possession or under their control any property of the said Cunningham Pennington are hereby required to transfer the same to the said receiver, and to execute to him such papers as may be necessary for that purpose. It is further ordered, that the said receiver do pay to the plaintiffs or their attorney the sum of Thirty Dollars, costs of this proceeding and also the fees and disbursements of this proceeding to be taxed by the Clerk, out of any money first coming into his hands as receiver.

It is further ordered that the said receiver, after paying all the principal, interest and costs that may be due and owing upon the judgment of the plaintiffs against the defendant, hold the remainder of the funds arising from this trust subject to the further order of this Court.
