 being in the County of Greenville and State of South Carolina
 on the west side of Reedy River near Reedy River Factory
 (formerly McPee's) and known as the Thomas Henson tract
 of land, containing one hundred and two acres more or less
 Our interests being one fourth of one half of said tract of land
 which is two thirds of the original tract of land deeded
 many years ago by Thomas Henson to his son James Henson and
 James two sisters said tract of land adjoins lands formerly
 of Frady and Hawthorne and of Jas. A. Ashmore - Together
 with all and singular the rights, Members, Accretions and
 appurtenances to the said premises belonging or in any
 wise incident or appertaining, To, Hirs and to, Heirs
 all and singular The said premises before mentioned unto
 the said Stephen A. Smith his heirs and assigns forever -
 And we do hereby bind ourselves, our heirs, Executors and admin-
 istrators to warrant and forever defend all and singular the
 said premises unto the said Stephen A. Smith his heirs and assigns
 against me and my heirs and against every other person or persons
 whomsoever lawfully claiming or to claim the same or any part
 thereof - Witness our hands and seals This 15th day of January
 1855 - and in the one hundred and ninth year of the Independence
