H. Perry, his Heirs and assigns forever. And I do hereby bind myself and my successors in office as Justice to warrant and forever defend all and singular the said Premises unto the said Th. H. Perry, his Heirs and assigns against me and my Heirs, and against every person whomsoever lawfully claiming, or to claim the same, or any part thereof. Witness my Hand and Seal this 27th day of November in the year of our Lord one thousand eight hundred and eighty six and in the one hundred and tenth year of the Sovereignty and Independence of the United States of America.
