 bargain, sell and release unto the said G. M.  
 Davis all that tract, parcel, piece or lot of land  
 situated, being and lying in the Town of Greenville  
 in the County of Greenville and State aforesaid  
 beginning at a stone on the East side of Broad  
 Street at the corner of Mill Street, thence along  
 Mill Street S 13° E 72 ft. to a stone on said Mill Street  
 and Victory Street, thence along Victory Street N 79° E  
 263 ft. 9 in. to a stone on said street and to corner  
 of Mrs. Foster lot thence along Mrs. Foster's line to  
 her inside corner to a stone, thence a straight  
 line to a stone on Broad Street, thence along  
 Broad Street to the beginning corner. Boundedly  
 lots of the said Jesse W. Cannon, Mrs. Foster & others  
 on Broad, Mill and Victory Streets, containing one  
 acre be the same more or less. Together with  
 all and singular the rights, members, hereditament  
 and appurtenances to the said premises belonging
