Presents, That I, Washington

Williman of Greenville County in the State
of one said for and in consideration of the sum
of One Thousand Dollars, to me in hand paid
at and before the sealing of these presents, by
Thompson W. Earle of said County & State the
receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged, have
granted, bargained, sold and released and
by these presents do grant, bargain, sell and
release unto the said Thompson W. Earle all
those three pieces, parcels or tracts of land, de-
scribed as follows, to wit: all that piece, parcel
or tract of land situate, lying and being in
the State and County aforesaid, at the crossing
of the Anderson and White Horse Roads, contain-
ing Thirty seven acres, more or less, and
bounded by lands of Wm Keith, Jas Benson
and others, Being the same tract of land
conveyed by W. J. Thumalt, assignee to J. A. Minnis
and by J. A. Minnis to me, Deed recorded in
office R. M. C. Book "K" page 268. Also all that
tract or lot of land, in County & State aforesaid
on the White Horse Road, containing Twelve Acres,
two rods & $\frac{29}{100}$ poles, more or less, Being the
same conveyed to me by E. A. Earle by deed
bearing date Dec. 6th 1884, Also all that tract
or lot of land, lying and being in the County
and State aforesaid adjoining the above
described tract, containing Nine and three
fourths acres, more or less, Being the tract
conveyed to Geo. Knight by W. A. Jones. Both
