G. Harris and Rev. F. Brown of said City, County and State (the receipts whereof is hereby acknowledged) have granted, bargain, sold and released, and by these presents do grant, bargain, sell and release unto the said Anderson Jones, G. G. Harris and Rev. F. Brown as Trustees, all that piece, parcel and lot of land situate, lying and being in the City of Greenville and State ofore-said, Beginning at a stake on a sixty foot street and running thence S. 21 $\frac{1}{2}$  W. Seventy-seven feet with said street to a stake, thence N. 55 $\frac{3}{4}$  W. to Alice Johnson's corner, thence with her line N. 28 $\frac{1}{2}$  E. Seventy-five feet to a stake and thence S. 55 $\frac{3}{4}$  E. one hundred and five feet to the beginning Being a part of a lot of land conveyed to me by Mrs. Mary W. Morgan by deed bearing date the twenty second day of August in the year of our Lord one thousand eight hundred and eighty-four. Together with all and singular the Rights, members, Hereditaments and Appurtenances to the said Premises belonging, or in any wise incident or appertaining. To have and to hold, all and singular the said premises before mentioned unto the said Anderson Jones, G. G. Harris and Rev. F. Brown, their successors in office heirs and assigns forever. In trust
