And we do hereby bind ourselves our Heirs, Executors and Administrators, to warrant and forever defend all and singular the said premises unto the said Mount Zion Baptist Church its successors and assigns, against us and our Heirs lawfully claiming, or to claim the same, or any part thereof. Witness our hands and seals this 15 day of January in the year of our Lord one thousand eight hundred and eighty seven and in the one hundred and eleventh year of the Sovereignty and Independence of the United States of America.
