 Beaversdam Creek; Beginning at a Maple 3x, op-  
 posite the mouth of a branch and running thence  
 up Enoree River to a bridge below the said mill, thence  
 along the road N. 80 W. 8. 50 to a white oak 3x3x, thence  
 N. 21 W. 1. 78 to a white oak 3x3x, thence up said River  
 with the meanders to the mouth of Beaversdam Creek  
 thence up said creek with the various meanders to a  
 stone 3x near the Rutherford Road, Hickory gone, thence  
 S. 72 E. 28. 15 to a stone 3x, Post oak gone, thence S. 87 E.  
 29. 78 to the beginning corner. Containing Fifty five  
 (55) Acres more or less. Together with all and sin-  
 gular the rights, meadows, hereditaments and  
 appurtenances to the said Premises belonging, or in  
 anywise incident to or appertaining. To have  
 and to hold, all and singular the said  
 premises before mentioned unto the said
