 J. S. Douthick, Master in and for the County, aforesaid, send Greeting: Whereas, Charles W. Stokes and Thaddeus O. Stokes as Executors of Abigail M. Stokes deceased and in their own right on or about the 15<sup>th</sup> day of September in the year of our Lord eighteen hundred and eighty four exhibited their Complaint in the Court of Common Pleas, for the County of aforesaid against William O. Stokes, Arthur O. Stokes, Robert Lee Stokes and others demanding judgment in relation to the real estate hereinafter mentioned and described; and the Cause being at issue, came on to be heard on the 11<sup>th</sup> day of July, 1885, and such proceedings were had thereon as resulted in a decretal order of the said Court whereby it was adjudged and decreed that the Master of said Court do execute and deliver to J. Eugene Stokes a deed to the tract of land which the Commissioners herein allotted to him, upon his paying the Master his cost for said deed. Now Therefore, know all Men by these Presents that J. S. Douthick, Master in and for the County of Greenville aforesaid, by virtue of said decree & in consideration of the sum of Three Dollars, to me paid by the said J. Eugene Stokes, all that tract of land situate, lying and being in the County and State aforesaid
