Know all Men by these presents, that I, James N. Morgan for and in consideration of the sum of Sixty-five Dollars to me in hand paid by Nelson A. Smith have bargained, sold and by these presents do bargain sell and release unto the said Nelson A. Smith, a certain tract or parcel of land containing sixty acres more or less situated being and lying in the State and County aforesaid on waters of Gap Creek and waters of Middle Saluda River, adjoining lands of William B. Johnson, deceased, a portion of the lands formerly owned by John Morgan, situated as follows: Beginning on a stake on McBeer's line at the fork stump on the trail running from old Gap Creek Road running to the head of the big Spring Branch where James Andrews formerly lived, thence South West to a Dogwood stake, thence a straight line to a chestnut oak on the west side of the big Spring Branch, thence South West to a corner Hickory on top Ridge, thence South East to John B. Johnson's line cornering on a chestnut oak, thence from chestnut oak along John B. Johnson's line to McBeer's line, thence with McBeer's line to the beginning. And I, James N. Morgan for the
