ing in the County of Greenville and State of Georgia  
on the Dunham bridge road near the incorporate  
limits of the City of Greenville, Beginning at a  
W. Oak x m. thence S. 59 1/2 E. 9.55 to a rock x m. thence  
S. 20 E. 5 to a corner, thence S. 52 E. 1.44 to another corner  
thence along the Dunham bridge road S. 52 W. 8.75  
to a rock x m. thence N. 55 1/2 W. 11.5 to a rock x m. thence  
N. 59 1/2 W. 13.45 to a rock m. thence N. 45 E. 11.82 back  
to the beginning corner, adjoining lands of A. L. Post  
Estate of G. M. Bee and others, containing sixteen  
and one half acres, more or less, excepting one  
x one half acres sold by Sarah Post to Susan  
H. Cobb. This being part of the lands once owned
