of South Carolina, in consideration of the sum of One
Hundred and fifty seven Dollars to me in
hand paid at and before the sealing of these
presents by J. C. Gowen (the receipt whereof is
hereby acknowledged), have granted, bargained
sold and released and by these presents do grant
bargain sell and release unto the said J. C. Gowen
three certain parcels of land lying in the City
of Greenville, containing two or two acres more
or less being part of a tract conveyed to Executor
of Est. Susan Thornton to Mrs. M. M. Carson 2nd
Jan'y 1883; to wit: a parcel containing 7/10 of an acre
adjoining lands of J. Judson, having the following
metes and bounds: Beginning on a stake at the
intersection of an alley 30 feet wide with said Judson
line and running thence East 192 feet to a stake
thence North 200 feet to a stake thence West 180 feet
to said Judson line thence with said line to the
