(the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged,) have granted, bargained, sold and released, and by these Presents, DO
GRANT, bargain, sell and release unto the said John Wheeler one (1/2) half interest
in Deaky Mills & Land which is all that tract or parcel of
land & Mills situated in the County of Greenville and State of
South Carolina on the Duck-hole of Middle River leaving the
following boundary to-wit: Beginning on a P.O. 3x, running with the
Wood 35 chains & 52 links to a stone 3x, thence N. 52 3/4 E. 12.55 to White Oak 3x,
thence N. 66 1/2 W. 23.6 to White Oak 3x, thence N. 18 1/4 E. 1.99 to a sweet gum 1x, thence N. 12 1/2 W. 19.30
