Holliday a tract of Land containing fifteen and thirty five one hundredths acres (15.35%) be the same more or less, it being lot No. 5 of the land divided by Jas. C. Holliday among his eight eldest children described as follows beginning on a stake with Lot No. 4, thence S 80° 44' W 57.50 chains to a Stake or on Saluda River then down the meanderings of the river to a Stake or with Lot 6 - thence N 80° 44' E 58.50 chains to a Stake or thence N 53° 44' W 2.75 chains to the beginning bounded by lot Nos. 4 and 6 of said Land, and Jas. Smith.
