County and State aforesaid on the South side of the White Horse road and on  
the head waters of Goldin's Horse Creek and having the following lines and boundaries  
beginning at a stone 30 m on the White Horse road East Ok ex on south side  
of road running thence 64 1/2 W 29. go to a stone 30 m thence N 60 E W 400 to a  
stone ex N 30 M. White line thence with said line 19.76 to a stone ex (Thence  
S 29 W 8.76) 6.75 to a stone 30 m thence N 44 1/2 E 35.28 to a stone 30 m on said
