Dollars, to me in hand paid at and before the sealing of these Presents, by Thomas E. Smith, do hereby grant, bargain, sell and release, and by these Presents, DO GRANT, bargain, sell and release unto the said Thomas E. Smith all that tract of Land situate in the County of Greenville and State of South Carolina, beginning at a located Cut 3x across the River on south side running thence N. 64° 48' E. 20.39 chains to a stone 3x om on the N. 36.00 chains line thence N. 52.12 E. 8.35 chains to a White Oak on South Bank of said Cane River 3x 0.1m thence N. 56.8.150 chains to a Pine 3x om across said River thence N. 64° 48' 3.64 chains to a Pine stump 3x 0.1m thence N. 42° 14' 48' 1.61 chains to a Stone 3x stones 3x 0.1m corner thence N. 61° 12' W. 13.00 chains to a stone 3x om on the East bank of Cullers Creek thence N. 65.
