Dickson all that certain tract or parcel of land situated in Greenville County and State aforesaid on Branch Creek, being a part of the old house place of Daniel Belue and bounded by my Father George W. Dill deceased and willed to me and bounded by lands of Charles C. Dill, James Wilson, John Lester, Jessie Moore, the road leading from Greenville City by way of Jefferson Mitchell and L. D. McRae containing forty four acres more or less. This Deed is to take the place of Deed given to said Dickson on the 11 day of December 1889 which deed the said S. C. Dickson acknowledges to be lost or misplaced.
