Louisa C. Bolling of the County of Greenville in the State of South Carolina
in the State aforesaid, in consideration of the sum of
One hundred (\$100) Dollars, to wit in hand paid at and before the sealing
of these Presents, by James Henry Allison of the County of Greenville in the State
(The receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged) have granted, bargained, sold, and released, and by these Presents, DO
GRANT, bargain, sell and release unto the said James Henry Allison all those four pieces
of land and lots of land &c. lying and being in said county and State of
South Carolina and having the following boundaries to wit
two lots designated on the plat of the land of J. Edwin Wash deceased as
lots 28 and 29, situate on the East side of the street containing one half acre more or less, fronting on
the East side of said street containing 14 links each making the entire front of
both lots on said street 28 chains and 4 links and running back from West street
at right angles thereto on parallel lines (2) two chains and (88) Eighty Eight links to the
back line which is parallel with and of the same length as the front line adjoining
lots 28 and 29 on the South side of said street on the West side of said street
said lot 28 and 29 on the same plat each adjoining of the other and said to contain each one half acre fronting on
the East side of McCall street each having a front of 1 chain and 14 links on
said East mentioned street and running back on parallel lines, at right angles with
said East mentioned street 2 chains and eighty eight links to the back line which is of the
