Know all men by these presents that
whereas Thomas W. Roe late of Greenville County and State aforesaid deceased
this life in peace and undisturbed on the 26th day of January 1888, signed
and possessed of a tract of Land containing 386 acres which he ever
since remained in the possession of his widow Sarah T. Roe, and
whereas the said Thomas W. Roe (decd) left surviving him no widow
at law and distributees, his widow Sarah T. Roe, and seven children viz.
Mary Ann Hawkins, Kegiah E. Watson, Sarah B. Hunt, Anna W. Carter,
Martha L. Ray, Susanna M. Moore, and Thomas W. Roe, all of which
are above the age of twenty-one years, and whereas no partition or division
of said Real Estate has ever been had, and being desirous to have the same
divided without recourse to the Courts, and where the said Real Estate was
surveyed at the request and by the consent of all parties in interest on the
9th day of March 1888, by J. K. Dickson S.S. and by him cut into eight

was assigned to Sarah B. Hunt, Tract No. 3 was assigned to Mary Ann
Hawkins, Tract No. 4 was assigned to Kegiah E. Watson, Tract No. 5 was
assigned to Thomas W. Roe, Tract No. 6 was assigned to Martha L. Ray,
Tract No. 7 was assigned to Anna W. Carter, Tract No. 8 was assigned
to Susanna M. Moore, and each party in possession of the tract assigned
to him or her or her assigns shall take up the same.

Anna W. Carter and Susanna M. Moore, for and in consideration
that the said Martha L. Ray has this day granted, Bargained sold
and released to us respectively all her right, title and interest in and
to the tracts of Land aforesaid to us respectively as above set forth and
and in the further consideration of the sum of five dollars as paid
by Martha L. Ray, the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged, have
granted, bargained, sold and released, and by these presents do grant
for gain, sell and release unto the said Martha L. Ray all our right,
title and interest in and to a certain tract of land belonging
to the Estate of Thomas W. Roe (decd) situate in Greenville County
and State aforesaid, on the East side of Reedy River and known
as Lot No. 6 in the survey made by J. K. Dickson the 9th day of
March 1888 containing 44 acres more or less, bounded as by said
survey attached, together with all and singular the rights, min-
ters, hereditaments and appurtenances to the said premises
belonging, in any wise incident or appertaining to have and to
hold all and singular the premises before mentioned unto the said
Martha L. Ray, her heirs, and assigns forever. And we do hereby
bind ourselves, her heirs, executors, and administrators to warrant
and forever defend all and singular the said premises unto the said
Martha L. Ray, her heirs, and assigns against us and our heirs
and against every other person whomsoever lawfully claiming or
claiming the same or any part thereof. Witness our hands and seals

hundred and eighty-eight and in the hundred and eleventh
