forty four and a half acre more or less lying and being in said  
district on the East side of Raburn Creek being a part of a tract  
Land originally granted to Samuel Peden and his wife and  
boundaries as follows. Beginning on a pine tree North of Thos C. Harrison  
dwelling house thence E 40° 75' to a Hickory in field. Thence S. 8 Chaine  
to a small rock in cane thence E along S Lane 10.50 to a rock in  
large cane thence N along S Lane 20.50 to a rock on Thomas Hill.  
Lode thence West along S. Walking line to Thos C. Harrison. Or in  
17 Chaine. Thence S th. to Thos C. Harrison's line 14 Chaines to the beginning  
corner & to have and to hold and I do hereby bind myself my heirs  
executors and administrators to warrant and defend the said  
 premises and to grant thereof and all that appertains as in any  
wise incident thereto to the S. Thomas C. Harrison his heirs and  
assigns forever. I declare under & have hereto set my hand &

and containing One hundred and one and a half acres more  
or less being the same tract of land of which the said James  
Templeton died seized and possessed of together with all and  
singular the rights, members, hereditaments, and appurtenances  
to the said premises belonging to him in any wise in aid of or  
pertaining to to have and to hold all and singular the premises  
before mentioned unto the said Robert League his heirs
