that the said Alexander McBee has agreed to lease and  
hereby does lease to the party of the second part a certain  
lot of spot of land say Twelve feet by Twelve feet situated  
in the City of Greenville in the State and County aforesaid  
on the right side of a branch running back of what is  
known as Turner's Warehouse upon which to erect a wood  
en powder house (Covered with tin or sheet iron) Twelve  
feet by Twelve feet, with the privilege of rights of way to and  
from the same for the term of five years from this date at an  
annual rental of Twenty four dollars, payable quarterly in ad-  
vance. The said party of second part hereby accepts the term  
of this lease and agree to pay the amount above mentioned
