Govey of the City and County of Greenville in said State (the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged) have granted, bargained, sold, and released, and by these presents do grant, bargain, sell and release unto the said Mrs. Connie C. Govey all that piece, parcel and lot of land situate lying and being on Westfield Street in the City of Greenville and County and State aforesaid containing five hundred and Seventy seven thousand and two acres of an acre more or less and having the following lines, mets and bounds to wit: Beginning at a stake on Westfield Street, Mrs. Mary H. Morgan's corner and running thence with her line N. 67 1/2° E. 280 feet to a stake on Dauthis Alley with said Alley N. 18 1/2° E. 520 feet to a stake thence S. 67 1/2° E. 280 feet to a stake on Westfield Street and thence with said Street S. 18 1/2° E. 520 feet to the beginning.
