The present owners of the joining lands to this lot are unknown to this grantor. But this grantor does intend to convey the aforesaid six acres more or less of land together with all the rights interests and title of the said Virginia Moon in said land with all the reversions, remainders, rents, issues and profits thereof to have and to hold the same into the said Robert L Rodgers his heirs and assigns to his and their only use benefit and behoof ever. And the said Mrs. Virginia Moon for herself her heirs executors and administrators does hereby covenant with the said Robert L Rodgers his heirs and assigns that she will convey the said premises unto the said Robert L Rodgers his heirs and assigns against all persons claiming or to claim the same by through or under her or them shall be will warrant and forever defend by these presents.
