 To Deed Now all men by these Presents, That I  
Wm H. Price Mary D. Brown of Chattooga County in  
 State of Georgia now temporarily in Richmond Co. Ga in con-  
 sideration of the sum of Three hundred and Seventy-five Dollars to  
 me in hand paid at <sup>and</sup> before the sealing of these Presents by William  
 H. Price of the City of Greenville South Carolina the receipt  
 whereof is hereby acknowledged have granted, bargained, sold <sup>and</sup> re-  
 leased and by these Presents do grant, bargain, sell, and release unto  
 the said William H. Price all that certain piece of land and lot of  
 land situate lying and being in the County <sup>and</sup> City of Greenville  
 in the State first aforesaid and designated as lot No 9 on the plan  
 of the lands of the late T. E. Stase <sup>and</sup> having the following bound-  
 aries: to wit on the North <sup>and</sup> South by lots 10 & 8 on the East by Dan  
 Street 44 feet wide on the West by lands of W. Fieldner <sup>and</sup> contain-  
 ing of one half of one acre more or less. It being the same lot  
 deeded to me by Louisa C. Bolling on the 12th May 1888 Deed  
 recorded in R. M. C Office in Book U. U. at page 303, together  
 with all <sup>and</sup> singular the Rights, Members, Hereditaments  
 and Appurtenances to the said Premises belonging, or in anywise in-  
 cident or appertaining. To have <sup>and</sup> To Hold all and singular  
 the said Premises before mentioned unto the said William H.  
 Price his Heirs <sup>and</sup> assigns And I do hereby bind myself my

 whomsoever lawfully claiming <sup>or</sup> to claim the same or any  
 part thereof Witness my Hand and Seal this 25<sup>th</sup> day of October  
 in the year of our Lord one thousand eight hundred and ninety  
 and in the one hundred and fifteenth year of the Sovereignty <sup>and</sup>

 and released and confirmed, and by these presents do  
 grant, bargain, sell, release and confirm unto the said  
 Dyer Blythe all that piece, parcel or tract of land lying  
 and situated in the state and County aforesaid, contain-  
 ing Fifty (50) acres more or less, and having the  
 following Metes and bounds, Beginning at stake on Rock  
 branch, thence N 77 W 22.50 to Wild Cherry on McCaull  
 line 819.44 2.62 to base of as. S 72 W 10.90 to Poplar 45.00  
 to S 74 E 4.00 to Cherry tree 152.68.80 to said line 186.5  
 2.10 to stake on branch, thence up the branch, thence up the
